Bethel Church Council Minutes August 12, 2013

Pastor Mike's Report: Pastor Mike's report included conducting three funerals, home and hospital visits, leading a Sunday service at the Freelandville Community Home, counseling sessions, and planning for youth activities to begin after Labor Day. He has also met with other area pastors to plan "Fifth Quarter" events that will be held for all area high school youth at the Freelandville Community Center following home football games. He shared that confirmation will begin after Labor Day.

Secretary's Report: Two corrections were made to July's secretary's report. Due to a misunderstanding with the company, the tombstone was not repaired but will be done in the near future. Also, due to a scheduling conflict, the date for worship in the grove and the Sunday school picnic has been changed to September 29.

Treasurer's Report: It was approved as written. The following mission allocations were made: North Knox Social Ministries, \$1,000; Bethel Pre-School, \$1,000; and, Christian Radio, \$700.

Deacon's Report: The average attendance for July was 135, and the offering was \$16,117.52. July income included: Atlas Gas, \$568.70; Interest, \$142.22; Mission Misc., \$125.00; Distress Fund, \$500.00; General Donations, \$301.00; Memorial Fund, \$50; and, Cemetery Fund, \$1,000.00.

Buildings and Grounds: It was reported that all the replacement windows are in place and the exterior doors for Bethel Hall and the basement ramp area have been ordered. Bill Resler is still waiting for bids for the projector and screen for the sanctuary. Jim Strange has made the necessary repairs on the mower, and he was thanked for the excellent care he provides for the church grounds. John Koenig thanked everyone for all their help with completing the work day projects.

Elder's Report: The visitation schedule for the elders and Pastor Mike was finalized.

Old Business: It was reported that the front steps have been recovered, and the contractor is in the process of completing the process on the Bethel Hall steps.

New Business: It was shared that Victoria Brocksmitth will be giving a report on her recent mission trip during a Mission Moment on August 18. The formation of a search committee for a youth pastor was discussed and will complete soon.


